



Forest Nursery Association of BC Educational Award

Rules and Regulations

The purpose of this award is to assist worthy students who are members or sons/daughters/grandsons/grandaughters/employees of an FNABC member to further post-secondary education.

1. Two annual awards for \$1000 each will be determined by the FNABC award committee by November 15 of each year.
2. Application for this award will be received at any time prior to the date of July 31, 2017.
3. Applicants must be sponsored by a member of the Forest Nursery Association of BC, and applications signed by the member sponsor.
4. Applicants must be planning to enter or return to postsecondary education within the 12 month period following the application deadline.
5. Financial need may be a qualifying criteria, depending on applicants. Please outline your budget for the next year (include income and expenses). Following is a sample format:

6. Preference for this award will be given to a student that is entering into the field horticulture, agriculture or a forestry-related field of study.
7. The Forest Nursery Association of BC (Educational award committee) is empowered to: -grant this educational award at its discretion -withhold this educational award in any year if there are no eligible applicants, or for any reason deemed good or advisable
8. The award will be payable on receipt by the FNABC of official documentation confirming acceptance into the post-secondary institution.
9. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
